BACKGROUND NOTE

16 students from the Faculty of Arts, Macquarie University are visiting India on a short term study programme as part of the Australian government's New Colombo Plan scholarship. They will be led by Dr. Andrew Alter, Senior Lecturer, Music Studies in the Department of Media, Music, Communication and Cultural studies. RESOURCE PERSONS

Ravindra Karnena is Assistant Professor of Sociology at the Department of Sociology, Lady Shri Ram College for Women. He teaches courses on Sociology of India, Political Sociology, Urban Sociology and Agrarian Sociology.

Dr. Leslie Keerthi Kumar SM is Assistant Professor, Political Science at Lady Shri Ram College for Women, New Delhi. He completed his PhD from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. He has presented papers and delivered lectures in India and abroad and is widely published. He was a visiting research fellow for six months at Free University, Berlin (2011) and has designed curriculum for the International Relations Programme of the Open University of Sri Lanka in a World Bank funded project (2013-2014). His research interests include IR theory, Radicalisation studies and India's foreign policy.

Dr. Vijayant Kumar Singh is Assistant Professor, Department of History at Lady Shri Ram College, New Delhi. He was awarded his Ph.D. in Medieval Indian History from Centre for Historical Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, in 2011. The title of his Thesis was "Environment, Society and the maritime Economy of Gujarat during the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries." Since then, he has presented in several conferences and published on Economy, Environment and Social Changes in medieval Gujarat during the 17th and 18th centuries. He has been teaching since September 2011.

Dr. Renu Bahl is Associate Professor of Political Science at LSR. Her research and teaching interests are in Indian Political thought, Religious and Gandhian Studies. She has spent time at several Gandhi Ashrams and written articles and chapters on Gandhi and his movements and Gandhian philosophy and movements.

Dr. Priya Kumari, is an Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Lady Shri Ram College. She has a Masters Degree in International Relations from Jawaharlal Nehru University (2007) and M.Phil (2010) and PhD (2015) in European Studies from School of International Studies, JNU. She has held fellowships at the Otto Suhr Institute of Political Science, Freie University Berlin (2012). She has worked with organizations like Commonwealth Human

Rights Initiative (2015) and think tank of Indian Navy, National Maritime Foundation (2014). Apart from regular popular media publications, she writes on international relations, India's foreign policy and human security. Her most recent publications are *Malaysia and Irregular Maritime Movement in Southeast Asia* and *India as a Normative Power*. She has presented her research work at several national and international conferences including ISA, the European Consortium for Political Research (ECPR) and WISC.

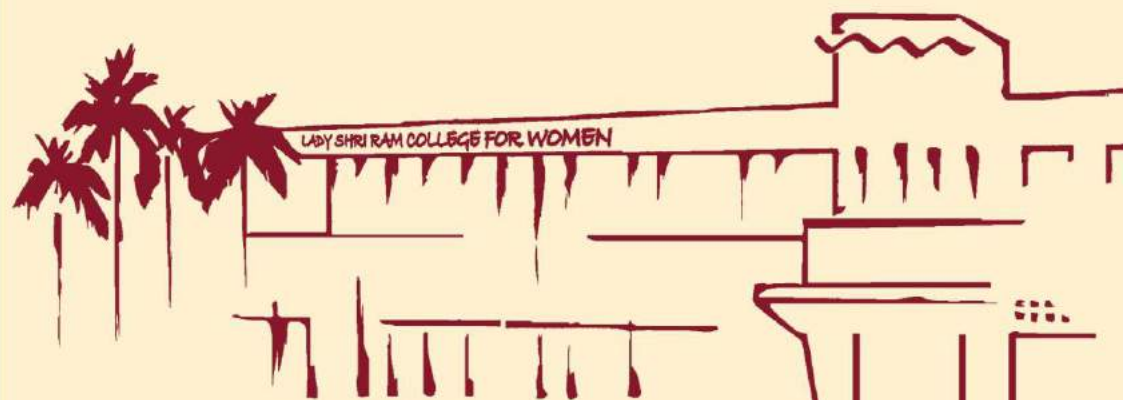

It was a delight to meet with you last week and I am so grateful for the warm welcome you and your colleagues extended to myself and my Monash colleagues. I feel we have a number of important areas of collaboration to develop.

While my entire trip to India was exhilarating and transformative the absolute highlight was being with your young women for the LSR chant. What a thrill!

I have cc'd here Professor Jacqui True, Director of the Monash Centre for Gender, Peace and Security and Professor Rita Wilson, Deputy Dean for Graduate Studies. I have briefed them on our conversations and have asked them, along with Dr Cecilia Hewlett, to advance the following:

1. Monash develop a named doctoral scholarship in the field of gender, peace and security to be made available to a suitably qualified graduate of Lady Shri Ram College. Monash and Lady Shri Ram College will work together to establish the details, process and protocols will need to be developed as well as the appropriate naming;
2. That Monash University set aside a second doctoral scholarship for the study of a comparative India-Australia project or such project that advances the understanding/relationships between Australia and India and include in that the opportunity to visit LSR;

5. We explore other areas of educational and research collaboration.

I may have forgotten or overlooked other items we discussed - if so I ask you to remind me! I feel we covered so much and am delighted to now build from our conversation.

I know I have introduced many colleagues in this email but I will ask Dr Cecilia Hewlett, Associate Dean International, to take overall oversight of all arrangements as they develop.

To advance discussions I propose we convene a teleconference with the both of us, Jacqui, Rita and Cecilia as well as members of your staff relevant to our discussions. I will ask Corrie to liaise with you to identify a mutually agreeable time.

Again I was energised by my visit to LSR, I am delighted to have engaged with you and I very much look forward to developing our relationship. I look forward to welcoming you to Monash University in July.

It was indeed wonderful to have you and your colleagues from Monash in LSR and the experience was invigorating for us. We apologize for the delayed response to your last mail regarding possible collaborations between LSR and Monash. We are very much interested and excited about your proposals. After extensive discussions between the Office of International Programmes and our Principal, Dr. Suman Sharma, we have the following suggestions to take the proposed ideas forward –

1. Monash University developing a named doctoral scholarship in the field of gender, peace and security for a suitable LSR graduate is an exciting idea.
2. As discussed with Dr. Suman Sharma LSR will be more than happy to receive and facilitate doctoral fellows as part of the proposed second doctoral scholarship for the study of a comparative India – Australia project or India/Australia relations.
3. We thank you for your invitation for Dr. Sharma to visit Monash University and she is very much keen to do the same to take our partnership to the next level. However, the dates need to be reworked as due to certain unavoidable work, she may not be able to attend the IPSA conference in July even though her paper has been accepted. Hence, a date in May/June 2018 or October 2018 will be suitable and we hope we can work out the details with Ms. Corrie McKee. If a set of dates in these months can be proposed by Monash, based on your convenience, then we can finalize them.
4. There can be a collaboration between our Post Graduate Diploma course on Conflict Transformation and Peace Building and some of your graduate course. Further Dr. Suman Sharma being the Director of the programme on “**Conflict Transformation and Peacebuilding** ” can give you some more ideas in the next meeting.
5. There are truly several other avenues of collaborations possible between our institutions. Possibilities like jointly organised Summer School Programmes for students are interesting. We already have such an arrangement with King’s College, London. Faculty exchange programmes and Annual Lecture Series can also be looked at. We hope that during Dr. Sharma’s visit to Monash University, some of these ideas can be developed further.

We once again thank you for your interest and support for collaboration between Monash University and Lady Shri Ram College for Women. We hope these ideas get crystallized soon. We look forward to receive your reply.

Dr. Vijayant Kumar Singh is an Assistant Professor, Department of History at Lady Shri Ram College, New Delhi. The title of his Thesis was “Environment, Society and the maritime Economy of Gujarat during the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries.” Since then, he has presented in several conferences and published on Economy, Environment and Social Changes in medieval Gujarat during the 17th and 18th centuries. He has been teaching since September 2011.

Manisha Chaurasiya is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science, Lady Shri Ram College for Women, University of Delhi. She is also pursuing her Ph.D. in Diplomacy and Disarmament, Centre for International Politics, Organization and Disarmament from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. She has four years of teaching experience. She has also widely published her research articles and chapters in reputed journals, books. Her research interest include Indian foreign policy, India’s nuclear policy, Politics and society in India.

Dr. Megha Dhillon is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Psychology, LSR College, where she has been teaching since 2010. She completed her doctoral degree in psychology from the University of Delhi five years ago. Her areas of interest include Health Psychology, Social Psychology and the psychological study of women’s experiences. Dr. Dhillon’s research work has focused on body image, street harassment, inter-group attitudes and children’s peer relationships in school settings. Her recent work has been on the designing and implementation of psychological interventions directed at changing inter-group and intra-personal attitudes.

Dr. Anisha Juneja is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychology, LSR College. She has been in the academic profession since 2013. Her areas of interest include mental health and parent-adolescent relationships. Her research work has also focused on discerning youth decision making in different domains of life as

She has spent time at several Gandhi Ashrams and written articles and chapters on Gandhi and his movements and Gandhian philosophy and movements.

Dr. Leslie Keerthi Kumar SM is Assistant Professor, Political Science at Lady Shri Ram College for Women, New Delhi. He completed his PhD from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. He has presented papers and delivered lectures in India and abroad and is widely published.
