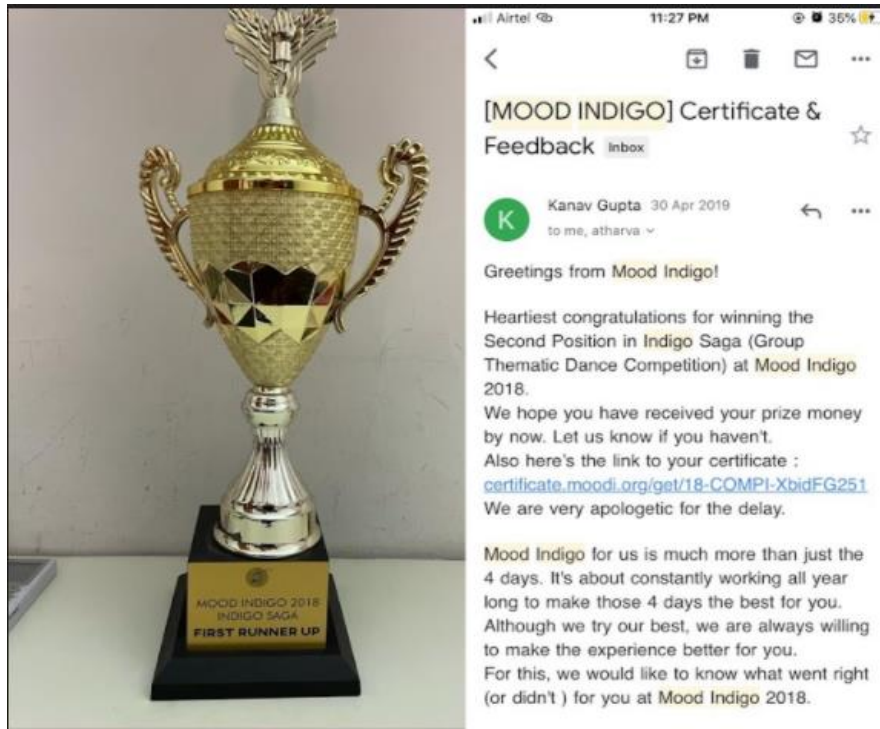

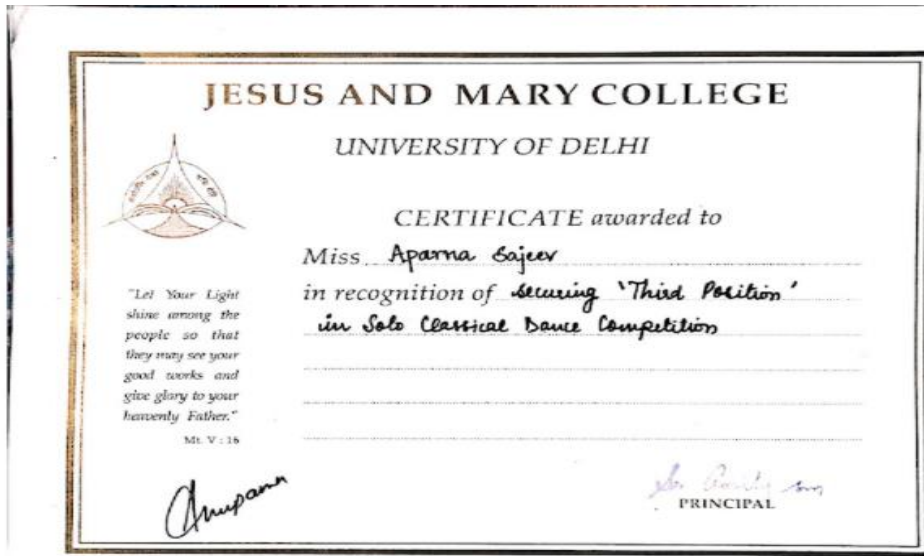

### Sports Awards Won in 2018-19

- i. Yukta Dave was selected for University of Delhi Badminton team, she represented Delhi in the North Zone and secured the first (gold) position.
- ii. Ishita Sharma participated in 57th Delhi states competition held at Indira Gandhi Stadium and bagged 2 Silver medals in the hoop and the ball event. She also participated in All India University held at Mahauli, Chandigarh in November 2018 and was selected for the apparatus finals for the hoop event. She came in amongst the top 25 players and was further recommended by the Delhi state's gymnastics federation to compete in the Khelo India games 2019 held in Pune. In the Khelo India games, she came in Top 8 and was qualified for the apparatus final for the hoop event.
- iii. In the Delhi University Inter College Judo Championship 2018-19 Akanksha Wali got the Gold Medal in -78 kg category; Saloni Yadav got the Bronze Medal in -70 kg category; Shivani Kumari in the -52 kg category and Saloni Yadav managed the Bronze Medal in the Open Category.
- iv. In the Junior Kurash Nationals, Karnataka 2018-19 Saloni Yadav got the Silver Medal in -63 kg Category and Saloni Yadav participated in the Senior Kurash Nationals, Aurangabad 2018-19. In Beach Kurash International Championship, Busan 2018-19 Saloni represented India in -63 kg category.
- v. Ananya Bhatt, History Honours, 3 Year Won a Gold Medal in 62nd National Shooting Championship, 2018 in 3 Position Jr. Women Event. Devanshi Rana, B.A. Programme, 2<sup>nd</sup> Year, won a Gold medal at the Khelo India Youth Games 2019, January held in Pune, Maharashtra; won a Silver medal at the 62<sup>nd</sup> National Shooting Championship held in Trivandrum, Kerala, 2018; bagged a Gold medal in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wajid Ali Memorial Shooting; and, received 2 Golds in World Cup Sydney in Air and Sports Pistol event in March 2018.
- vi. In the Haryana State Open Aquatic Meet 2018 Anjali Sangwan got the Gold Medal in 50m Butterfly and 200 IM and a Silver Medal in 50m Breaststroke and a Bronze Medal in 50m Freestyle. In the University of Delhi Inter College Aquatic Meet 18-19 Hunar Deshwal, Rashi Rana, Anjali Sangwan and Jasmine Chawla won the Bronze Medal in 4 x 200m Freestyle Relay and the Bronze Medal in the 4 x 100m Freestyle Relay. They also got the Gold Medal in 4 x 100m Medley Relay. Jasmine represented the Delhi University at All Indian Inter University and she got the Gold Medal in 4 x 200m Freestyle Relay and the Silver Medal in 4 x 100m Freestyle Relay. Jasmine represented the Delhi state at Youth Khelo India Nationals.
- vii. Bhuvaneshwari Rathore and Sayesha Jain won the Gold Medal in Symbiosis law School Open Table Tennis Tournament 2019; in the Delhi Technical University Open Table Tennis Tournament 2019 and also in the Dr. Bharat Ram Open Sports Meet 2019. Bhuvaneshwari Rathore also participated in the Youth National championship 2018 and Sayesha Jain participated in the Senior National Championship 2018.
- viii. Rashi, Garvita and Bani got the 1<sup>st</sup> position in Shivnadar University Sports Fest for Tennis. Rashi and Garvita got the 1<sup>st</sup> position in Delhi Technological University (DTU) Sports Fest.
- ix. With their excellent performance the Volleyball team bagged the Gold medal in ATHLEEMA Annual Sports meet. Vishalakshi Rana participated in Delhi Senior State championship and got Silver.
- x. In the Open Delhi State Athletics Tournament (2018) Charu Shoukeen won the Gold Medal in 100m and Radhika Gulati won the Silver Medal. Charu

Shoukeen also participated in the Senior National event (2018) and also managed to get 4<sup>th</sup> position in the “Born to Run Marathon (2018)” and won a cash prize of Rs. 2000/-.
