## Detailed Guidelines for Department Elections

### Draft Guidelines for On-Line Elections to be conducted by Departments in 2020-2021

1. Department Union Elections should be conducted between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021.
2. All current first, second and third year students (Fourth year also in case of B.El.Ed. Department) of that specific department are allowed to vote on the basis of one vote per post. Voting will only be on the basis of the student's name being in the electoral roll of that Department.
3. Students who would like to stand for President should belong to the third year and those standing for Secretary and Treasurer should belong to the second year.
4. Any student can stand for one post only.
5. All nominations should come in at least a week before the date fixed for elections. Two days can be allowed for any withdrawal.
6. An election committee consisting of the TIC, Association-in-charge and senior most teacher of the Department should be set up. All grievances related to the election should be referred to this committee. Only if the grievances cannot be resolved at the Department level, then they can be referred to the Staff Advisors to the Students' Union.

## Detailed Guidelines for Society Elections

### Broad Guidelines for On-Line Elections to be conducted by Societies


1. The electoral roll of the Society will be drawn up on the basis of students who are members of the Society. The electoral roll should have students of all three years. Once the roll is drawn up, it must be countersigned by the Staff Advisors of that Society and only those students will be entitled to vote.
2. All current first, second and third year students of that specific society are allowed to vote on the basis of one vote per post. Voting will only be on the basis of the student's name being in the electoral roll of that Society.
3. Students who would like to stand for President should belong to the current second year and those standing for Secretary and Treasurer should belong to the current first year.
4. Any student can stand for one post only.
5. The election process should be made as short as possible. All nominations should come in at least a week before the date fixed for elections. Once the list is announced, one day can be allowed for any withdrawal. Canvassing should be limited to three days maximum.
6. Staff Advisors should be present at the official confrontation if it is held and voting should happen soon after the confrontation.
7. The Senior most faculty member of the Society Advisors of that Society will be the Grievance officer. 2 other Staff Advisors will be the electoral officers and carry out the election. Grievances that cannot be resolved by the Grievance Officer of that Society can be referred to a larger Grievance committee for Society Elections which will consist of the senior most Staff Advisors of the Societies. Any negative campaigning/bullying incidents arising out of the electoral process should be handled by the Grievance committee of each Society.


**General Guidelines sketched out in detail pertaining to College Union, Department Union, and Society Unions**

**General Guidelines**

1. Distribution of money or gifts or any kind of favour will lead to DISQUALIFICATION of the candidate from the elections.
  2. Candidates are advised to refrain from expensive campaigning.
  3. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which creates mutual hatred or causes tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
  4. Criticism of other candidates shall be confined to only their policies and programs, past record and performance. Candidates shall refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life, not connected with the public activities of the other candidates or supporters of such other candidates. There should be no criticism of other candidates, or their supporters based on unverified allegations or distortions.
  5. No canvassing for votes on the basis of caste, region or religion is permitted.
- 
6. As far as possible, all students to be encouraged to canvas using the written form such as messages, emails or WhatsApp to make the process as equitable as possible and not give undue advantage to those with better network facilities.
  7. In case a student is unable to vote during the window provided for voting, she should inform the teachers who are the election officers immediately so that they can take necessary action. Societies are requested to figure out in advance and publicize how they would handle such a situation.

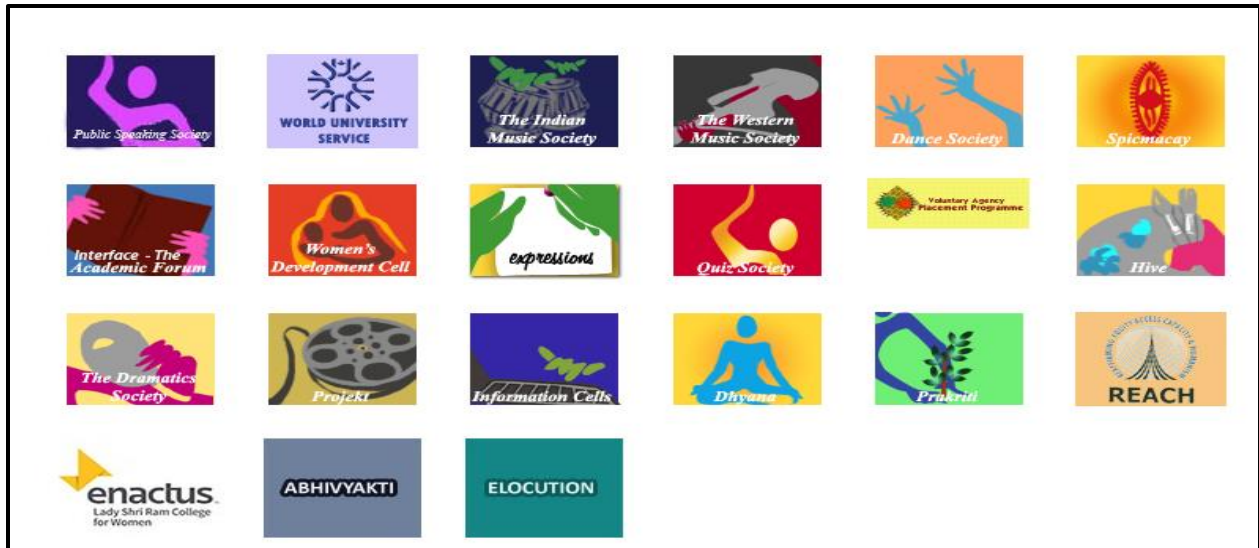

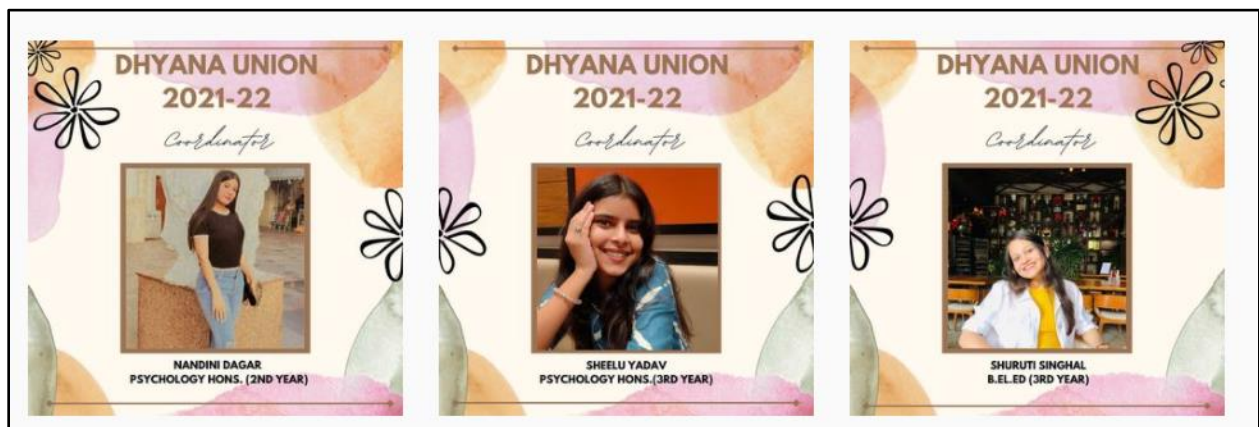
