The Department of Journalism, LSR had requested its students to provide feedback for the Academic Year: 2020-2021. The feedback was collected using the Google Forms application. The students of the Batch of 2022 and the Batch of 2023 were asked to fill the feedback forms, who are currently studying in the 5th and 3rd semester respectively. The students gave a positive response, and also offered their suggestions on how to make online learning more engaging.

The majority of the students agreed that the faculty members are regular and punctual in taking online classes, readings/e-resources are disseminated effectively, and the course is covered on time. The students also agreed that online classes are discussion-based, interactive, and engaging as teachers actively use teaching aids such as PPTs, videos, podcasts, and Ted talks during online classes.

More than 80% of the students acknowledged that teachers always helped them when they were facing difficulties or doubts in academics, and are always available for support and guidance. Students also believe that teachers provide them with feedback on their work, and also offer guidance on higher courses of study and future career prospectus.

Students agreed that they were collectively benefitting from association activities, society activities, and were offered opportunities and the right platform for engagement with social issues.

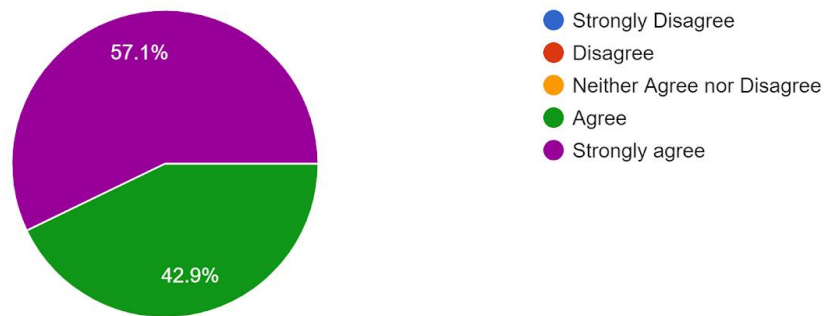
The suggestions given by the students are as follows -

- The staff and admin can be made more accessible in matters related to scholarships/freeships.

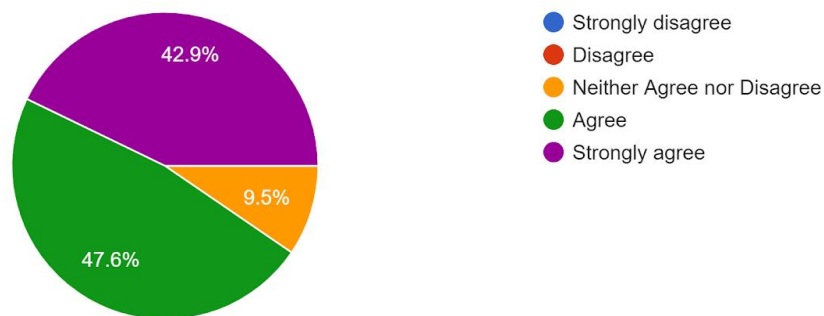
- Overall the faculty members are really supportive and understanding. Whatever can be done in an online mode of studying they have done that and made their class interactive and informative.

The detailed outcome of the form is mentioned below –

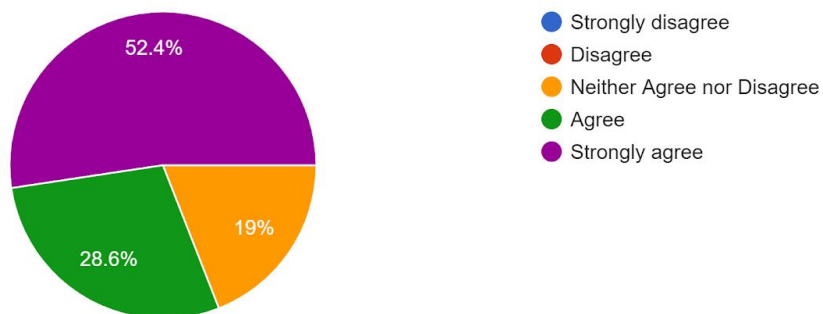
a) Faculty members are regular and punctual in taking online classes.



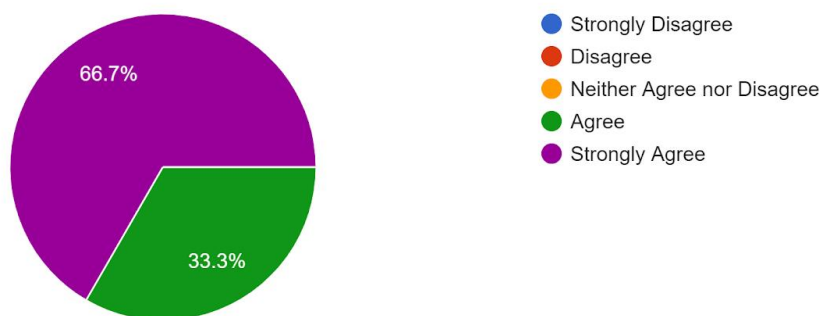
b) Readings/E-resources are disseminated and course is covered on time.



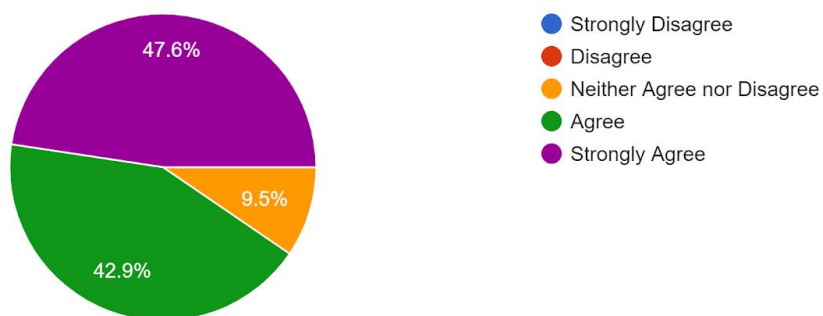
c) The online classes are discussion based, interactive and engaging



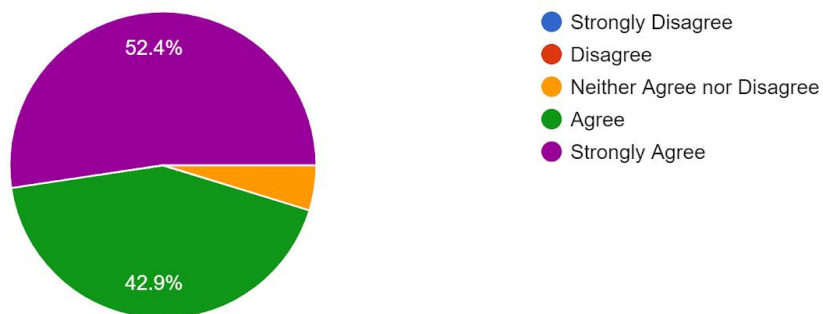
d) The teachers use teaching aids such as PPTs, videos, pod-casts, Ted talks during online classes



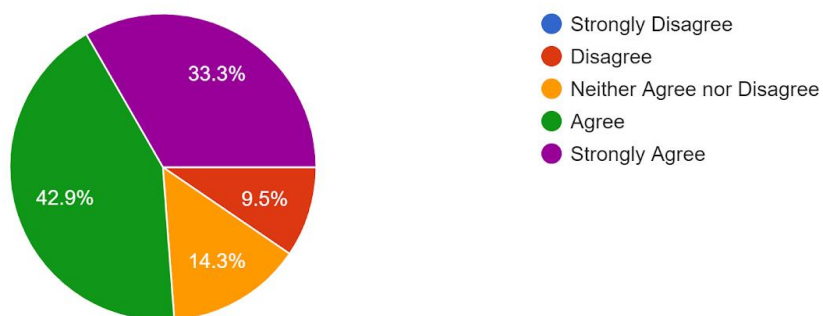
e) The teacher pays attention to students facing difficulties or doubts in academics



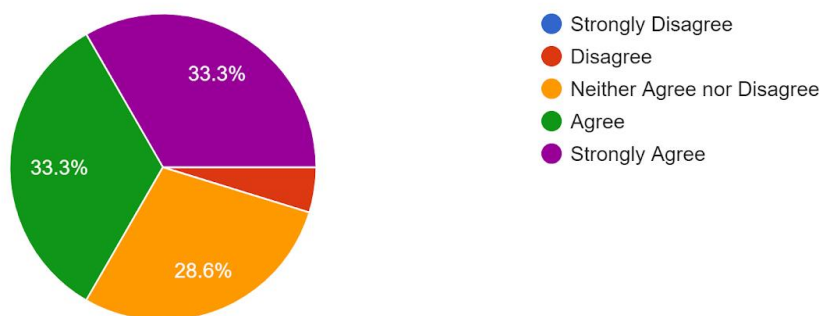
f) Periodic online assignments are conducted and evaluated as per schedule.



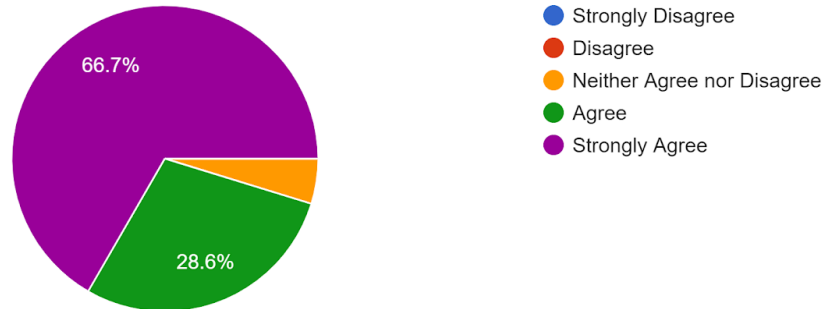
g) Feedback is provided to students on their performance in the assignments



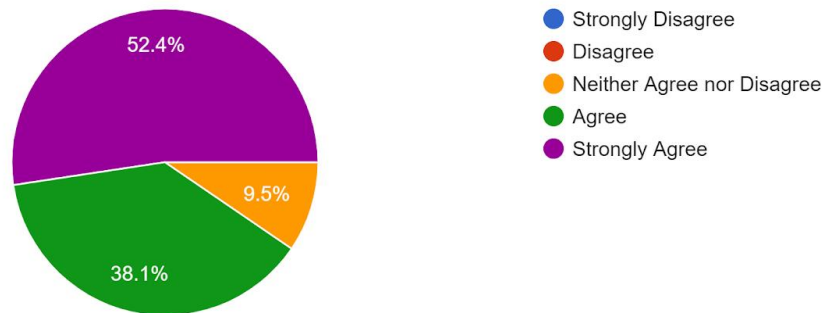
h) Teachers provide guidance on higher courses of study and future career prospectus



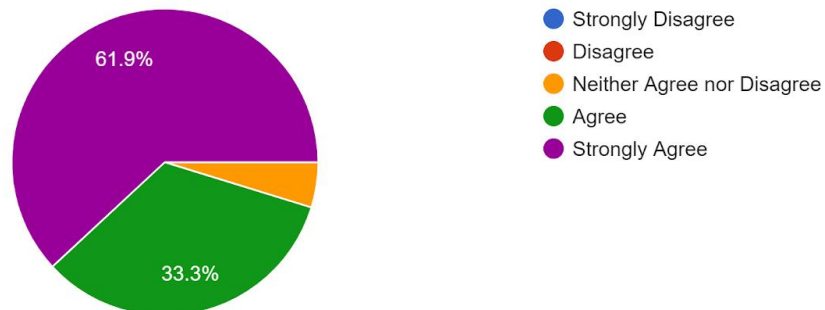
i) Association activities (e.g., online talks, seminars, academic meets) are interesting, participative and good learning forums for students



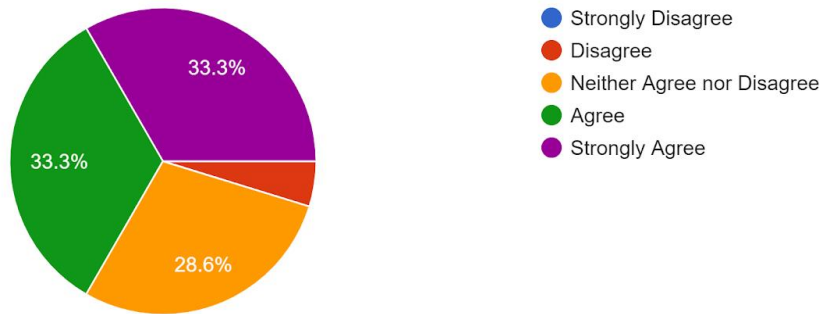
j) Adequate opportunities for research are provided in the department.



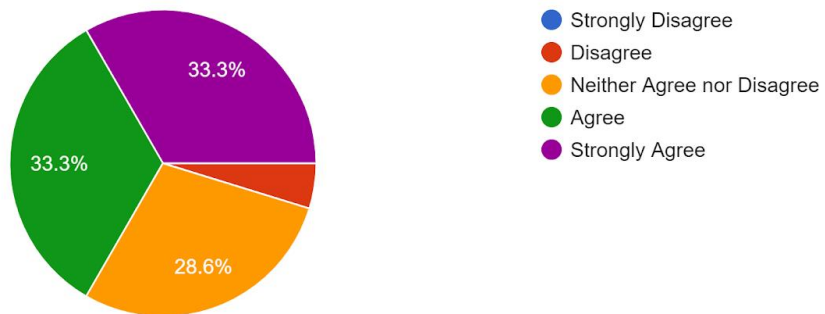
K(a) Teachers are accessible and available for support.



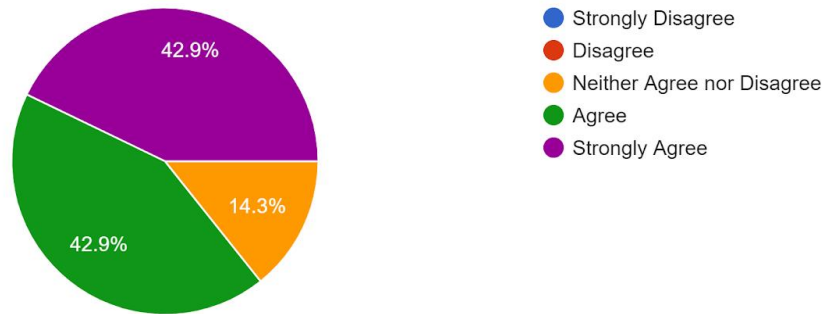
K(b) Grievances to college can be reported even in online mode.
