The expenditure on teaching positions approved for 2nd tranche may be incurred out of the funds provided under salary head (36) of Annual allocation of 2019-20.

The above approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

Colleges may fill up the teaching positions at the earliest.

College may strictly adhere the reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PH as per li. Govt. of India policy while filling up the teaching positions.

The UGC Regulations 2018 related to Minimum qualifications for appointment of III. teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in Higher Education should be strictly followed by all Colleges.

Iv. The workload of the Associate Professor promoted from Assistant Professor under CAS be carried forward with him/her and be undertaken by the promotee even in the capacity of the CAS Associate Professor.

It is also informed that the College should also ensure, no post would be filled up without express approval of the UGC in future.

Creation of Teaching Posts in Colleges of the University of Delhi on account of expanded student numbers related to OBC reservations

Dear Colleague,

As per directives received from MHRD/UGC pertaining to implementation of the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act 2006, each college undertook to expand student intake by 54%. The UGC had sanctioned a tentative outlay for meeting the non-recurring and recurring expenditures for this purpose, as was indicated to you in my letter of August 27, 2008.

I am now writing to inform you that your college has been sanctioned 46 additional teaching posts for meeting the increase in student numbers by 54%. The University is given to understand that the number of additional teaching posts for each college has been calculated on the basis of 1:18 teacher student ratio. Kindly also note that, of the abovementioned posts, in the first tranche, the number of approved teaching posts for your college is 23.

The college is advised to take required steps to advertize and fill up the 23 teaching posts sanctioned in **the first tranche**. The college may work out the subject-wise distribution of these posts on the basis of increase in student intake, and the relevant UGC norms. All rules relating to mandatory reservations must be strictly adhered to. **Draft advertisements for the teaching posts must be sent to the University for prior approval along with a copy of the roster approved by the University.**

The University shall shortly write to the college to indicate the source of funds for incurring expenditure relating to the new appointments including the expenditure involved in advertising for these posts.
